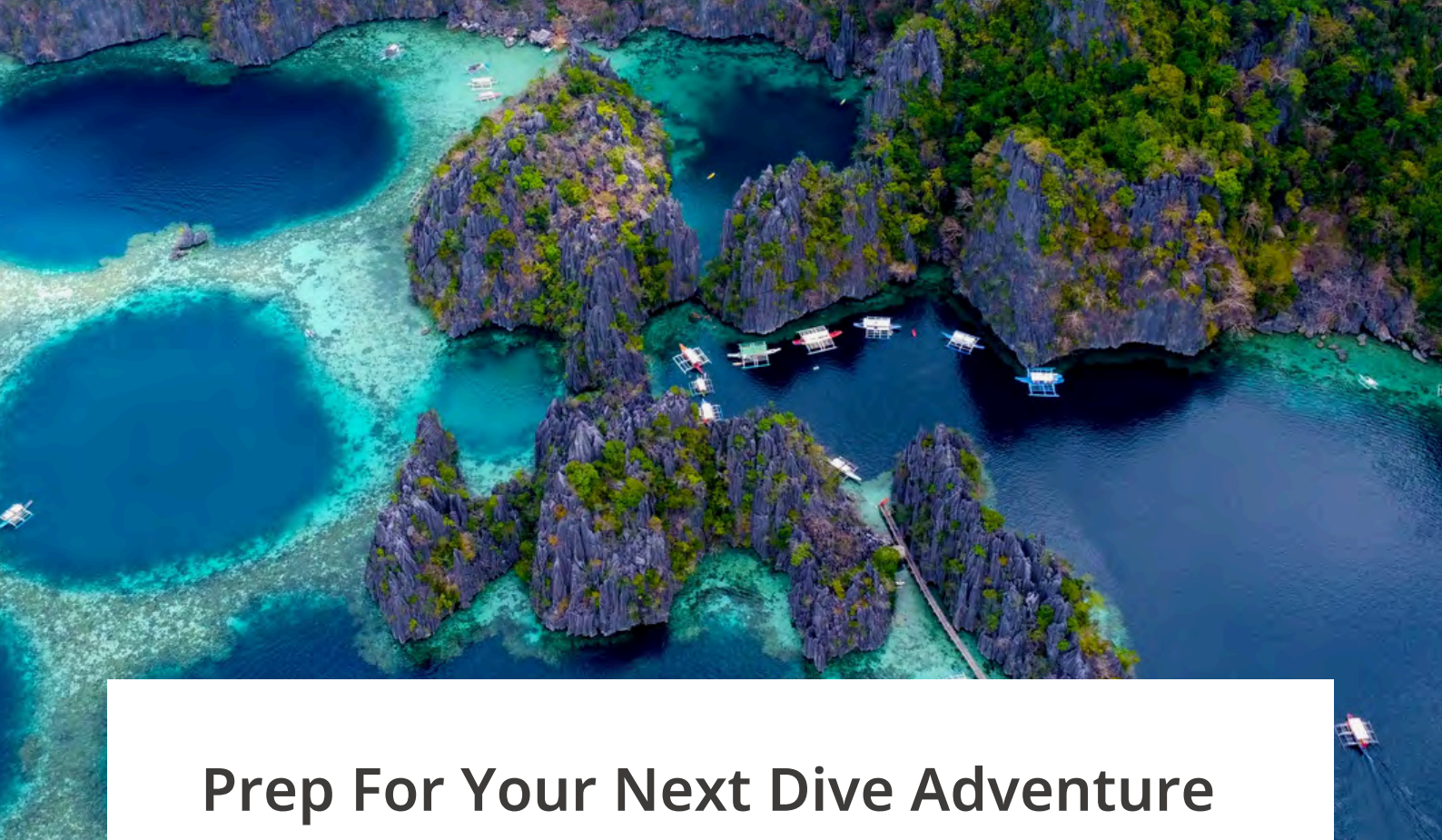

# Scuba Gear

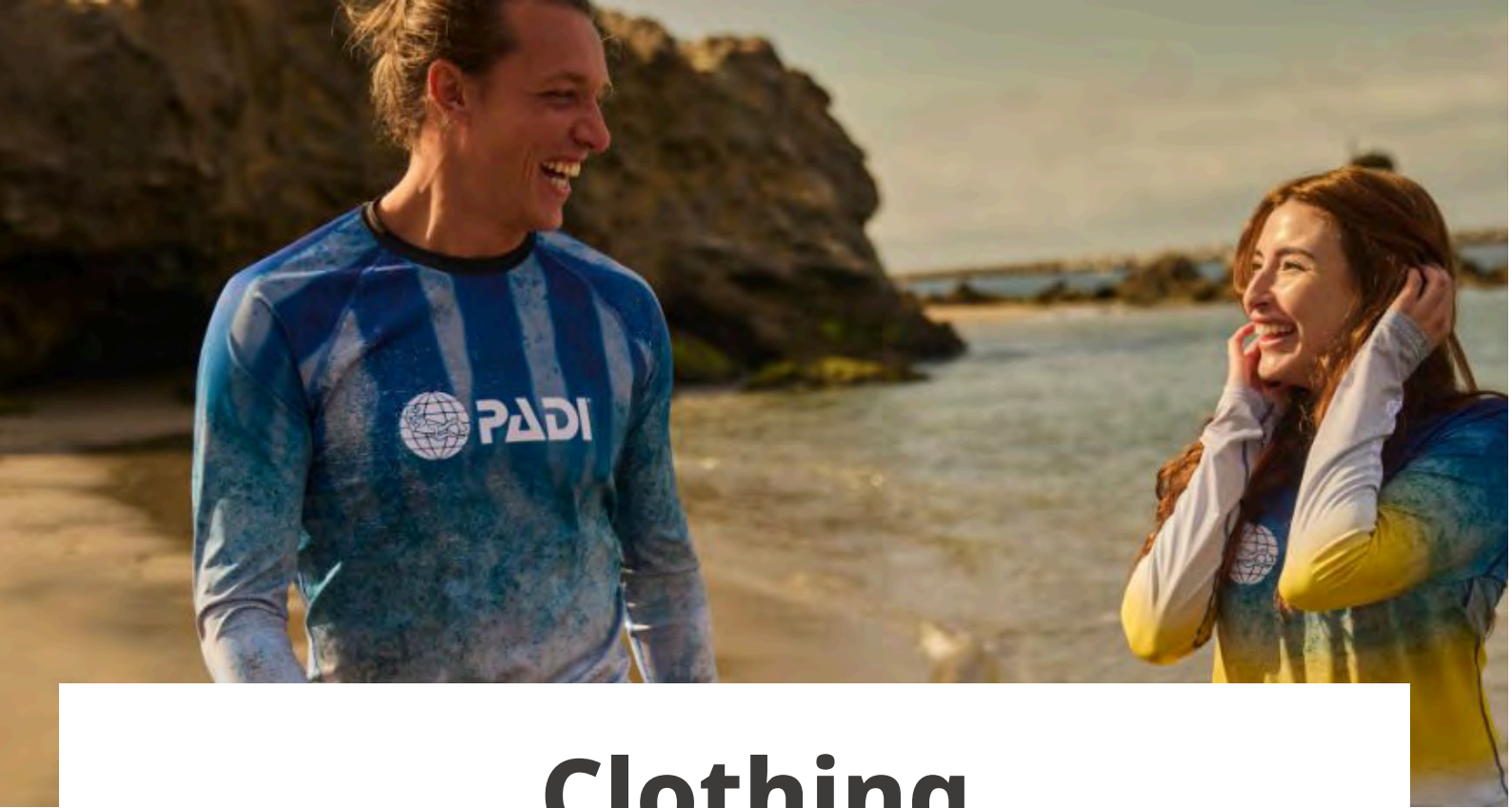


- Scuba certification card (*misplaced your card or want a new design? [Get one here.](#)*)

- Lycra socks if using full foot fins
- Booties
- Buoyancy compensator
- Wet suit, dry suit & hood if diving in cold water
- Gloves
- Dive knife (don't carry on)
- Regulator with gauges + air integration sensors
- Air horn or whistle
- Dive computer and spare batteries
- DSMB or SMB with reel
- Double enders to clip any gear to your BCD
- Dive torch/light
- Light stick
- Spare O-rings
- Weight pockets for BCD
- Logbook (*easily log all of your training and recreational dives in our [digital logbook](#)*)

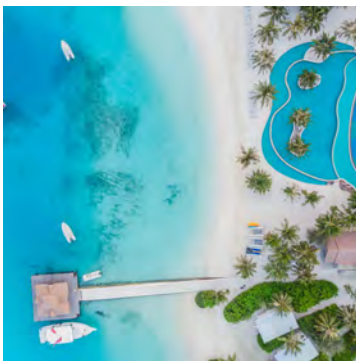
